**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING
PURCHASE CONTRACT PROPOSAL FOR ONE TYPE III MODULAR AMBULANCE
REMOUNT FROM LIFELINE EMERGENCY VEHICLES, SUMNER, IA**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously contracted for purchases of new type III modular ambulances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has received a Purchase Contract Proposal for the Remounting of one Type III Ambulance from Lifeline Emergency Vehicles, in the amount of \$119,500.00 plus Washington State sales tax in the amount of \$9,440.50, minus \$4,800 from Ford government rebate program, for a total cost of \$124,140.50 and

WHEREAS, the design and quality of ambulances built by Lifeline Emergency Vehicles in Sumner Iowa matches the current ambulance fleet and will maintain the warranty of the ambulance module unit; and

WHEREAS, this remounting of this new unit will enable the fire department to update this existing ambulance in the fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the acceptance of this Purchase Contract Proposal for one type III modular ambulance remount is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety, and welfare of residents of the City of Sunnyside.


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON**, as follows:

Section 1. That the Purchase Contract submitted by Life Line Emergency Vehicles, Sumner Iowa, for one new type III modular ambulance remount is hereby accepted and authorized, all in the total amount of \$124,140.50 including all applicable taxes and charges, such purchase being justified through the sole source conditions to maintain the warranty of existing Life Line components.

Section 2. The City manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents deemed necessary and appropriate to accomplish such purchase, all in accordance plans and specifications on file with the City of Sunnyside.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval, and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


