Rules and Regulations for Use:

1. Application must be completed by an adult 21 years of age or older.
2. Applicant shall be responsible for any damage to equipment or property.
3. When a rental is cancelled after the reservation fees have been paid, the applicant waives the right to any refund.
4. All patrons are required to follow the pool rules (see back). The group must follow the directions of the pool staff.
5. Pool reservations are required at least two full weeks (14 days) in advance of the use date requested.

Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Food and drink are permitted only on picnic tables and benches. No glass or metal containers in the building or pool area.
2. No smoking or vaping in or near the pool area. Being under the influence of, or possessing, alcohol or drugs in the pool area is prohibited.
3. Showers are required before entering the pool.
4. No unnecessary talking with lifeguards while they are on duty. Their attention should not be diverted from pool.
5. Stay off lane lines and ropes.
6. No running in the building or on the pool deck.
7. No horseplay, shoving, pushing, vulgar language or disrespecting pool staff.
8. Only Coast Guard approved lifejackets are permitted in the pool area.
9. No masks, snorkels, flippers or other swim equipment are allowed during recreational swimming. Such items may be used during lap swim or instruction programs with Parks and Recreation Department approval.
10. No one with a communicable disease, open sores, or suspected of having an infection, fever, cold, inflamed eyes, or skin disease will be permitted in the pool. People ill with vomiting or diarrhea within the last two weeks may not use the pool.
11. Persons with a history of health conditions such as seizures, heart conditions or circulatory problems should be accompanied by a responsible person in the water with them.
12. All patrons entering the facility will be charged a daily admission fee or must possess a current pass. The only exceptions are for observing swim programs, and parents/legal guardians seeking a child to return home.
13. Only authorized personnel allowed in office and chemical rooms.
14. No one is allowed in the pool without a lifeguard present.
15. Diving is only allowed in designated areas.
16. Swim suits are required. No shorts or shirts with buttons, zippers, rivets or other hard objects will be allowed. Full length pants will not be allowed. Suits, clothing, and cover-ups deemed as ill-fitting or offensive will not be allowed.
17. No animals allowed in the pool facility, except service animals.
18. Swimmers under the age of 3 years old must be accompanied by an adult (18 years and older).
19. The City of Sunnyside is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
20. Swim diapers are required for infants and children not toilet trained. A protective cover must be worn to prevent contamination.
21. See the rules posted at the waterslide for waterslide rules.
22. See the rules posted at the diving boards for the diving board rules.
23. Additional rules may apply to various swim activities. Lifeguards must be obeyed at all times. Patrons not following facility rules may be subject to removal from the premises.
24. Refunds may be granted for reasons including, but not limited to, pool closures or, on a case by case basis, for removal from a pool program for failure to abide by pool rules and regulations.
